As the state of Indiana continues to gradually and safely reopen, schools have been given guidance through the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) and the Indiana Department of Health (ISDH) regarding recommendations and considerations for safely reopening schools through a 38-page document titled IN-CLASS.
