

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF NORTH WHITE SCHOOL CORPORATION

The Board of Trustees, North White School Corporation met in a Regular Meeting on Monday, October 10, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the office of the Superintendent at 402 E. Broadway St., Monon, Indiana according to Indiana Code 10-5-3-2, Public Law 57, and the rules of the Board. - 3.2 Mr. White recommended that the Board approve to adopt the 2023 NWSC Budgets as advertised. Mr. Williams moved to approve these recommendations. Mr. Denton seconded and the motion carried 6-0. See "Exhibit A".
- 3.3 Mr. White recommended that the Board approve the Budget Resolution to Reduce 2022 Appropriations, 2023 Appropriations & Miscellaneous Revenue Adjustments for 2022 and 2023. Mr. Williams moved to approve this recommendation. Mr. Denton seconded and the motion carried 6-0. See "Exhibit B".
- 3.4 Mr. White recommended that the Board approve a change in wording to the 2022-2023 NW Middle/High School Student Handbook, regarding entry to school after the school day begins. Mr. Briles presented the change to reflect "The doors to North White Middle/High School will remain locked during school hours. Parents, guests, or students reporting late **MUST** enter through the front doors (Door 1 north side) of the building". ~~Students who drive to school may enter through the doors at the multi-purpose room (Door 15 South side).~~ Ms. Princell moved to approve this recommendation. Mr. Denton seconded and the motion carried 5-1, Mr. Williams opposed. See "Exhibit C". Discussion was held between the Board, Mr. Eccles and Mr. Briles.
- 3.5 Mr. White recommended that the Board approve an Eight Day Central American trip for Mrs. Salvo's Spanish classes. This trip is being organized by EF Educational Tours. The total cost of the trip will be \$2,589 (\$155 monthly payment). The trip is planned for spring break of 2024. Mr. Robertson moved to approve this recommendation.
