### **2021-2022 Dyslexia Information from North White Elementary**

**Dyslexia intervention program used:** Orton-Gillingham

**Number of students who received dyslexia interventions:** 34 students (K-2nd, 3rd Rtl)

**Number of students identified with dyslexia:** 0

**Number of students identified as “at risk” for displaying characteristics of dyslexia:**

**Kindergarten:** 6

**1st Grade:** 2

**2nd Grade:** 4

Locally, North White has determined that being considered “at risk” means that, of the assessments used for dyslexia screening, the student was below the cut score on all six subsets within the assessments.

**Number of students identified as “at some risk” for displaying characteristics of dyslexia:**

**Kindergarten:** 10

**1st Grade:** 2

**2nd Grade:** 5

Locally, North White has determined that being considered “at some risk” means that, of the assessments used for dyslexia screening, the student was below the cut score on more than one subset within the assessments.

**Note:** If a student being administered the universal screening assessments for dyslexia characteristics is also an English Language Learner who has scored between a 1.0-1.9 on the WIDA assessment, that student may not have been included in the “at risk” or “at some risk” category for dyslexia characteristics, as their language levels may have prevented an accurate academic performance measure. These students will continue to be monitored for language acquisition and assessed, but will not necessarily be included in interventions for dyslexia.
